Meeting called to order at 7:02 PM

Old Business

Nancy Lawrance read the minutes from the 10/10/11 meeting. There was no discussion. Pat Cullison made a motion to accept the minutes as read and Joan Brock seconded.

Sally Creed reminded parents that online wreath sales would still be in effect until Dec 4.
